

Who Can Request a Review?

National public employees subject to the Law on Salaries of Public Employees in Regular Service (hereinafter referred to as “the Remuneration Law”) can file a request for review.

Details are as follows:

Employees who can file a request

- Full-time regular services (including employees during the conditional appointment period)
- Temporary employees
- Fixed-term employees
- Re-employed employees
- Part-time employees

Employees who cannot file a request

- Employees of Specified Independent Administrative Institutions
- Employees of state-run enterprises which engage in state-owned forestry business
- Employees of Japan Post
- Prosecutors
- Retired employees (Cases filed by an incumbent employee are reviewed even after retirement of the employee.)
